

THE VISA IN VIEW OF CONTRACTING MARRIAGE IN BELGIUM

DOCUMENTS REQUIRED

For application submission of the visa in view of contracting marriage in Belgium with the Belgian citizen or other national who legally resides in Belgium, you should submit documents in person to the Belgium Embassy in Kiev with the following documents:

1. Travel document (national passport), that must be valid within 12 months and must have a page for the visa.
2. Two dully filled and signed visa Application Forms, three recent and identical photographs.
3. Medical certificate issued by the doctor accredited by the Embassy (valid within 6 months).
4. Certificate on absence of previous convictions (valid within 6 months) covering the period of the last 5 years.
5. Proof of financial means in Belgium or guardianship certificate of the person who has sufficient means and is a Belgian citizen or other national and has a residence permit in Belgium. Formal obligation annexe 3bis that guarantor should take in a commune in a place of residence. After the declaration was taken the original has to be provided to the Embassy or Consulate within 6 months after legalization, together with the following documents:
 - Documents which confirm solvency of the guarantor: salary slips for last 3 months and-or last tax declaration;
 - Family composition certificate of the guarantor;
 - Copy of Belgium ID card/passport or residence permit.
6. Family composition certificate: celibacy certificate, divorce certificate, death certificate (translation is required, original and translation must be apostilled).
7. Copy of the declaration on marriage intension, issued by the Registrar's office in a place of residence that must be valid within 6 months.
8. The proof of the valid international medical insurance, personal or collective, that will cover medical expenses during travel, urgent treatment and/whether urgent treatment in hospital. You should conclude the insurance contract directly in the country of residence. If the inviting party concludes the contract instead of you, then he/she has to do it in the country of his/her residence. The insurance policy should be

valid on the entire territory of Shengen area. Minimum insurance coverage is 30 000 euros.

- *You have to refer to corresponding administration (commune) in a place of residence within 8 days after arrival to Belgium.*
- *You have to submit originals of documents and two copies of each document to the Embassy or consulate. Originals will be returned.*
- *The above list of documents is compulsory. The Embassy reserves the right to demand for any other additional documents from the applicant.*
- *Persons submitting false documents to the Embassy will bear the responsibility according to current legislation.*
