

INFORMATION FOR PERSONS WHO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO OBTAIN A TRANSIT VISA

A – AIRPORT TRANSIT

B – 5 DAYS MAXIMUM

B- FOR SAILORS

1. Travel document (national passport) valid for the period of predestined sojourn in Belgium + 3 months;

Two passport data page copies and one copy of previous visas.

In case of child travelling with you, it is necessary to submit his/her travel document. Otherwise, the Embassy will not accept the visa application irrespective of child's age.

2. One application form completely filled in French, Dutch, German or English, personally signed and dated.

3. Two recent colour photos (identical).

4. Visa of destination country.

5. Booking of tickets for plane, bus or train.

In case of travelling by car: a copy of driving license + vehicle registration certificate should be presented.

6. For B visa: hotel booking for the whole period of transit.

7. For sailors:

- Reference from the place of employment,
- Financial obligations concerning sojourn from Ukrainian company or organization,
- Seamen's book,
- Invitation from Belgian company or organization.

8. It is obligatory to submit **DURING VISA REQUEST** the international insurance policy valid for all territory of the Schengen zone and visa validity term. The insurance sum is 30 000 Euros.

!!!ATTENTION!!!

- All documents in Ukrainian or Russian should be translated into one of national languages of Belgium or English. The translation of the documents should not be obligatory certified by an accredited translator or notarized.
- If you reside not in a hotel but in private address in Belgium, you should be registered in a commune and receive the arrival declaration during three days after the arrival.
- **!!!The consular department reserves the right to demand any additional documents!!!**
- Persons submitting false documents to the Embassy will bear the responsibility according to current legislation.
